A blend of Touriga Nacional and Alfrocheiro from granite soils at 400 m. Deep crimson. Rich, lightly perfumed dark fruit. Very immediate and direct on the palate: dry, almost chalky tannins, tight and upright with spicy dark fruit and no sign of oak, which is perhaps what gives it this tension on the palate. A wine with a rocky mineral undertow, pure dark fruit and no artifice. Needs food if you plan to drink it soon. (JH)
