60% Touriga Nacional, 40% Alfrocheiro planted on granite at 400 m. 60 days' post-fermentation maceration. Unoaked.

Mid crimson. Aromatic with dark fruit, blackberry, a touch of spice and the merest hint of the typical Earl Grey (bergamot) aroma of Touriga. Juicy and supple on the palate, the tannins seems light but they still give a good framework for the fruit. Fresh, lively and juicy – so much so that you could enjoy this without food but it should be good at the table too. Versatile and refreshing. Lovely unforced balance. (JH)
