



Andreza Grande Reserva Red DOC Douro 2014

Drink: 2019- 2026

60% Touriga Franca, 40% Touriga Nacional. Schist soils. 12 months in French oak.

Dark like black cherries. Sweetly spiced on the nose but the floral character of the Touriga Nacional shows through the oak, as does the dark rocky quality I associate with the Douro's schist soils. Dark, rich and generous on the palate. Chewy, mouth-filling and very satisfying. Tannins are quite dominant at the moment and I would wait another year or at least drink this with food. Should age well and has good length. Needs time to become more refined. (JH)
