



## Insurgente DOC Dão 2015

70% Touriga Nacional, 30% Alfrocheiro. Granite soil at 400 m. 90-day postferment maceration.

Deep cherry red with purple rim. Fragrant with the floral and bergamot aromas of classic Touriga Nacional without the interference of oak. Plenty of sweet dark fruit balanced by dry, fine and savoury/rocky tannins. The depth of fruit is nicely contained by the tannin/acid framework. Chewy on the finish and much too young to drink now, though you could possibly try it with something seriously meaty. Lovely dry, fine-grained finish. (JH)
