Deep garnet. Spicy and dusty on the nose, firm and chewy on the palate. There's plenty of dark fruit but not as sweet as Merlot can sometimes be though there is some sweetness from the oak. Lots of grip and good acidity. A food wine for sure. A little bit of heat on the finish but persistent and should age well over the next few years. (JH)
