



Tyto Alba Sauvignon Blanc DOC do Tejo 2016

Cool fermented and aged three months on lees.

Fragrant and almost peachy on the nose rather than green or grassy, and some lively citrus. There is a a very slight phenolic grip – what seems like a light tannic texture – and this adds both interest and length. Has good freshness from this warm region. Should go well with plain fish dishes though you could also drink it on its own. (JH)
