Touriga Nacional, Trincadeira, Alicante Bouschet. Six months in French oak.

Mid crimson. Restrained nose with some fruit sweetness – both red and black. Notes of white pepper and cedar. Really juicy and fresh on the palate – and refreshing. Dry but silky tannins and mouthwatering finish. I'd drink it while the fruit is still bright and lively.
