



Andreza Red Reserva 2011, DOC Douro

40% Touriga Nacional, 40% Touriga Franca, 20% Tinta Roriz grown on schist. TA 5.3 g/l, pH 3.72. 12 months in new French oak. Deep crimson. Oaky nose – sweet spice and a touch of char. But there's also the floral side of Touriga Nacional shining through. Nicely dry tannins, fresh given the alcohol, but, like the 2010, could do with a little less oak to allow more of the fruit character and the region to be expressed. Chocolate-covered cherries on the finish but still juicy.
