Deep dark crimson. Intensely fruity – cherry and damson and blackcurrant – with a nice fresh, slightly cedary layer over the top. Rich, juicy and full of fruit. Well structured, straightforward and lots of flavour with freshness and a touch of spice on the warm finish. Just something ever so slightly harsh at the very end. Still very youthful.
