Touriga Nacional and Merlot. 50% fermented and aged, with bâtonnage, for four months in used French oak.

Relatively deep pink. Sweet red fruits on the nose and a hint of creamy vanilla. Tastes a little bit like hard candy even though it is apparently dry - but there's a cream red-fruit sweetness that gave me the impression of higher residual sugar than the stated 1.54 g/l. Plenty of fruit flavour and a tangy freshness, almost a touch of citrus (?orange) on the finish. Happy sort of wine. (JH)
