



Tyto Alba Sauvignon Blanc DOC do Tejo 2017

Fermented in tank and aged on lees for three months. More citrus and chalky herbs than anything extreme but the fruit is ripe and crisp. Definite flavours and aromas without excess pungency. Light, fragrant and delicious. It is very much in its own style, with an orange-pith fragrance and citrus purity. I'm not normally a fan of international varieties in Portugal, where there are so many great indigenous ones, but this has its own character and has been nicely made. Gently creamy texture from the lees adds depth to the fresh length. Best vintage of this wine I have tasted. (JH)
