Fermented with indigenous yeasts, 20% whole bunch, aged one year in clay amphorae.

Mid crimson and looks a little older than it is. Sweetly spiced red fruits. Lovely chewy texture of moreish tannins and all that sweet fruit and spice balancing the firm structure. Full and broad in the mouth and with a long spicy finish. Good to see this made in this traditional Tejo style. Really something to get your teeth into without being at all tough. (JH)
