A blend of Fernão Pires and Arinto. Spontaneous ferment in oak barrels and three months with bâtonnage.

Quite delicate aromas that are both floral and more like grapefruit. But also a peachy richness of stone fruit. Really quite complex. That same complexity on the palate, a creamy texture with a light grip but also all that lovely freshness and depth with a lightly salty finish. Satisfying in being complex and lively. Long, chalky finish. (JH)
