Spontaneous ferment and aged on lees in tank.

Fragrantly grapey and floral, almost a rose-petal fragrance, delicate and pretty, but also with the brightness of clementines. Amazing that you can get all these aromas from a grape. It's bone dry, scented on the palate as on the nose but with a nice chalky texture from the lees. Moderate concentration but lovely scent from start to finish. Not sure if this would go with food but a fine late-afternoon aperitif. Perfumed but fresh and light. Well done! All the pitfalls of such an aromatic variety have been avoided. (JH)
