



### Tyto alba Sauvignon Blanc 2014, DOC Do Tejo

Tyto Alba means Barn Owl, apparently, and its presence on the estate is a sign of their careful land management. Fermented at 14 °C and 2 months on lees. TA 6.8 g/l, RS 9.2 g/l.

Very pale straw. Classic and inviting Sauvignon Blanc aromas - citrus and fresh herbs. The residual sweetness is not as obvious as I expected and in fact balances the acidity well, though it does just show a little on the finish. Personally I'd prefer it drier at the end to leave your mouth cleaner and fresher but I can see this would be a successful and popular style for lovers of bright fruity Sauvignon.
