



## 2015 Touriga Nacional Tyto Alba

The 2015 Touriga Nacional Tyto Alba was aged in 70% well-used oak and 30% new oak, mostly French. It comes in at 14.5% alcohol. Elegant and fairly easy on the first taste, despite its youth, this is bright and lively, although the creamy, oak-induced texture obscures that early on. Showing nice intensity of flavor, this ultimately does well as it airs out. It always lacks a bit of focus, but it has reasonable structure, depth and flavor. It will be approachable young, but give it another year if you can. That will allow it to pull in some wood and moderate that bite on the finish. There were 1,100 six-packs produced.
