The 2014 Branco Grande Reserva Andreza is a blend of 30% Viosinho, 30% Verdelho, 10% Rabigato and 30% Arinto, aged for eight months in well-used French oak of varying ages (with about 5% new). It comes in at 13% alcohol. This late release has fine solidity for a 2014, plus a nice, lingering finish with grip and fine balance. Filling the mouth nicely, this shows good fruit on the long finish and the acidity to support the fruit. It is very well done and nicely priced. It should age well, too.
