



2018 Andreza Reserva Branco

The 2018 Reserva Branco Andreza is a very dry and equal blend of Viosinho and Verdelho aged for seven months in new French oak. It comes in at 13% alcohol. In bottle a little less than three months when tasted, this was showing well. It has wood around the edges, but it does well in suppressing vanilla nuances, considering the new wood and the recent release. The mid-palate concentration is average at best, and it has only modest intensity. I liked its sibling, the regular Reserva Branco Lua Cheia, slightly more for its better finish, but they are pretty close. This might have a little more personality.
