The 2015 Reserva Album is a 40/30 blend of Petit Verdot and Alicante Bouschet with 20% Syrah and 10% Aragonez, all aged for ten months in new French oak. It comes in at 14.5% alcohol. This is a nice bargain in its youth. Elegantly crafted, velvety in texture and very precise, it has reasonable concentration for the level and a bit of beef (the Alicante and Syrah?) mingling with the oak for complexity. It's not a big or a deep wine, but the balance on this graceful tinto is perfect. Drink it on the young side, however; it's ready now and it will not likely turn into anything much more. It's worth leaning up for the moment. There were 4,966 six-packs produced.
