



2015 Andreza Reserva

The 2015 Reserva Andreza was aged in a 70/30 mixture of used French oak and stainless steel for ten months. It comes in at 13.5% alcohol. Light in the mid-palate, this nonetheless has a completely charming feel—it's lively, fresh and flavorful. It also has a bit of tannic pop still on the finish, but you can certainly approach it now because the tannins are reasonably ripe. This silky wine has a bit of a Burgundian feel this year. At least in its youth, it is an overachiever and a great food wine. When warm weather gets here, it is also the type of red that can benefit from being drunk a few degrees cooler than normal. There were 15,800 six-packs produced.
