The 2019 Reserva Branco Andreza is a dry and equal blend of Viosinho and Verdelho aged for seven months in new French oak. It comes in at 13.7% alcohol. Nicely wrought, this tightly wound Branco has some bite on the finish, reasonable concentration and lingering flavor. The expression of fruit is admittedly muted a little by the wood, but this actually handles the wood well—this is not drenched in vanilla. Overall, this is a middle of the road white that is well crafted and a perfect food wine. It should hold well for several years, maybe more, and it might still improve a bit.
