



## 2016 Pegos Claros Rose

The 2016 Rosé had partial (20%) oak aging (five months in second-use French barrels). It comes in at 13.5% alcohol. Nicely constructed, this has fine body for a pink with controlled flavors, some orange peel and dried strawberries. It's not the type of pink that gives you big acidity—it's the type with the stuffing to hold up to food—but it is surprisingly fresh. This is well done, perhaps even better than last year's. Not yet imported, there were 590 six-packs produced.
