



2017 Andreza Códexa do Larinho

The 2017 Códexa do Larinho (Andreza) is unoaked and very dry. It comes in at 12% alcohol. This is quite a mouthful this year, relatively full-bodied for the brand, although perhaps not quite as intense. Fruity and nuanced by that bit of lime I often seem to find, this rolls around the palate nicely and tastes great, finishing dry and clean. Drink it on the younger side—it will be great this summer—but it can hold a couple of years. It's a very nice value, as always, although that price spread the winery gave me is substantial. There were 3,330 six-packs produced.
