The 2015 Branco Tyto Alba is mostly a Fernão Pires, with 10% Verdelho blended in. It was aged for just three months in new French oak and comes in at 12.5% alcohol. This might be my favorite for this brand so far. It doesn't have a lot of zing and power, but the fruit is ripe and rather glorious in its youth. Use it with lighter foods or all by itself. It will be great this summer, but don't hold it too long. This fresh white should be consumed young for best results.
