The 2011 Reserva em Vinhas Velhas white is an old vines field blend aged for 6 months in new French oak. Despite the relatively modest oak treatment, it shows far too much vanilla, which did not fully resolve with air and warmth. It flattened after an hour or so, seeming just a touch flabby. Still tasty, it has some charm. There were 566 six-packs produced. This is not imported as yet. Drink now-2014.
