



### 2009 Andreza Reserva DOC Douro red

A Proprietary Blend Dry Red Table wine from Douro, Portugal

The 2009 Reserva "Andreza" Tinto is 40% each of Touriga Nacional and Touriga Franca, with 20% Tinta Roriz. Beautifully balanced, with a touch of oak up front, this brings its parts together very nicely, providing a caressing texture, some depth and concentration and pretty good persistence on the finish. This is quite appealing in a rather laid back fashion, not terribly intense but rather charming; not terribly complex, but with some concentration and focus. It does a lot right at a nice price. It should make some friends for the producer. Drink now-2018. This is in the Wines and Winemakers by Saven stable. Note: The producer was formerly listed as Aguia de Moura, where the wines are made, with Lua Cheia em Vinhas Velhas just as the brand name. I-m advised that was because, when the bottling first launched, the paperwork had not been finalized on the creation of the Lua Cheia corporate entity. The Andreza line represents the upper level brand. This is part of the Wines and Winemakers series by Saven. There is no importer at this time.
