The 2012 Album is an unoaked blend of Aragonez 50%, Syrah 25% and Alicante Bouschet 25%. Showing some considerable astringency on the finish in its youth, this is clean and a bit stern, reasonably well-structured and more like real wine than most in this modest price range. Its equally modest mid-palate concentration is more typical of the price range, but it should make a nice food wine and charming house-pour. It drinks well. Drink now-2019.
