The 2015 Rosé is an old vines field blend, unoaked, dry and coming in at 12.5% alcohol. This is some mouthful. Big, deep and mouth-coating, it has fine concentration for a Rosé and takes no prisoners. It has nice grip on the finish, too, but its structure is not quite as impressive as its depth. It finishes with dried plum flavors. This is a very fine effort and a nice bargain. Close your eyes, let it warm a bit and you will think you have a red.
