A Proprietary Blend Dry White Table wine from Setubal, Portugal

The 2014 Branco Dona Helena is a blend of 34% Moscatel, 33% Fernão Pires and 33% Arinto. It comes in at 3.8 grams per liter of residual sugar, close to but under the typical, fully dry limit. Not the biggest and deepest wine, this nonetheless provides nice acidity and invigorating aromatics, with the Muscat and some hints of green together dominating the nose. Very tasty as well, it finishes dry and rather crisp. This is a nice bargain. Drink it young and fresh for best results, no matter how long it theoretically lasts.
