The 2010 Grande Escolha Pegos Claros is all Castelao aged for 8 months in a mixture of new French and American oak. The oak, it is fair to say, stands out quite a bit, giving this a one-dimensional feel and oak-derived aromatics and flavors. Underneath is a wine that is rather elegant in the mid-palate with reasonably good structure. At the moment, however, it is hard to find. If the oak calms down and integrates, this should have more of a chance to succeed, but that may take a while. This is not imported as yet. Drink 2016-2024.
