The 2014 Branco Samora is a tank-aged blend of Fernão Pires and Arinto, coming in at 12.5% alcohol. Over the years, this has been a fairly consistent bargain-basement white, showing a little concentration and viscosity, a fresh feel in its youth and a pleasing finish. There is just a touch of green around the edges. Just drink it young and fresh and it will be a great picnic wine. The longer you hold it, the less happy you'll be.
